Women of Influence in the New Testament

- **Matthew 28:1-10** - _____ and the other Mary; the first to proclaim the message of the resurrected Savior. Before any of the apostles shared the heart of the gospel, these women did
- **Acts 9:36-43** - _____, which, translated, means Dorcas; full of good works and acts of charity
- **Acts 12:11-12** - _____, the mother of John Mark; had opened her home as a place for Christians to pray
- **Acts 16:14-15** - _____; a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God. She showed great hospitality to Paul and those with him, even after they had been arrested, beaten, and imprisoned (**16:40**)
- **Acts 18:1-3** - _____; a tentmaker. She traveled with Paul through part of his missionary journeys (**18:18**) and with her husband, Aquila, took Apollos aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately (**18:24-26**). All the churches of the Gentiles were thankful for her work and sacrifice (**Rom 16:3-4**)
- **Romans 16:1-2** - _____; a servant of the church at Cenchreae and patron of many
- **Romans 16:6-15** - Paul mentions at least _____ women and compliments them greatly
- **1 Corinthians 1:11** - _____; had such concern for the church in Corinth that she reported to Paul the problems of division, making way for great teaching in that church
- **Philippians 4:2-3** - _____ and _____; had labored side by side with Paul
- **Colossians 4:15** - _____; had opened her home as a place of worship
- **2 Timothy 1:5; 3:15** - _____ and _____, grandmother and mother of Timothy
- **1 Timothy 5:9-10** - "_____ indeed"; had provided indispensable work in the church
- **Titus 2:3-5** - the blessing of _____ women in the lives of _____ women
