What is **FAITHFULNESS**? All over the Bible, over and over again, we hear three **REALLY** important words: **God is faithful**.

God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son ... (I Cor 1:9)

God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability ... (I Cor IO:13)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins... (1 John 1:9)

When we walk by the Spirit, connected to Jesus, we'll let our **trust** in God lead us to **obey** him. We'll "walk in a manner worthy of the calling" to which we have been called "with all humility and **gentleness**" (Eph 4:1-3). So what **IS gentleness**? Let's talk about it together...


