For Class & Family Discussion:

- When you think gentleness, what comes to your mind?
- What does Jesus mean when he describes himself as "gentle and lowly"? Why is that really good news?
- Ephesians 4:1-3 calls us to bear the fruit of gentleness. What does gentleness have to do with being "eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace"?
- When you hear the often repeated phrase, "God is faithful," what comes to mind? What does it mean?
- In everyday practical terms, what does it look like for human beings to be **faithful**?
- What does our trust in God have to do with obedience?
- How does "walking by" the Spirit (Gal 5:16), following the "lead" of the Spirit (Gal 5:18), "keeping in step" with the Spirit (Gal 5:25) and "sowing to" the Spirit (Gal 6:8) produce the fruit of faithfulness?
