Hell: What Can We Know About It?

- Jesus described and warned about the “hell of fire” more than anyone in the Bible, using the Greek word *Gehenna* (*ge*, “valley” and *henna*, “Hinnom”)—originally, a ravine on the south side of Jerusalem (Josh 15:8; 2 Chron 33:6; Jer 7:31; 2 Kings 23:10)—to describe:
 - A place of eternal, unquenchable _____ (Matt 5:21-22, 29-30; 10:26-28; 18:7-9; Mark 9:42-48; James 3:6; Rev 19:20)
 - A place of gloomy, utter _____ (Matt 25:30; 2 Pet 2:4, 17; Jude 6, 13)
 - A place of eternal destruction, away from the _____ of the Lord (2 Thes 1:5-10; Phil 3:18-19; Rev 20:10-15; 21:7-8)
